Steps to complete the accomodation booking:

Step 1

Fill in and send the form "Hotel Booking Application Form" on or before August 15th 2026 to: **hotel.porec.tkd@gmail.com** (Form available at the AETF web page for this event). After this date we cannot guarantee places in the hotel or the above mentioned prices. The organizers will check your booking and send you an invoice for prepayment of 50% of the total amount for each person listed in the form (on or before October 15th. You may pay the whole accommodation amount in advance if you wish to do so.

Please note that the booking will not be confirmed until the requested amount has been registered in the organizer's account. Please remember to pay the transfer costs from your side, if the Organizing Committee has to pay for the transfer costs then you will need to pay this back on arrival.

Step 2

After the amount has been accounted, your booking will be officially accepted. This will be confirmed to the responsible person of each delegation.

Step 3

50 % of the accommodation balance must be paid on or before 15th of October 2026 and the full balance (the remaining 50%) on or before 15th of November 2026. The full accommodation amount may also be paid on or before 15th October.

Note! All hotel payments must be made electronically to the organizer's account according to the due dates.

Step 4

It is possible to make small changes in the hotel accommodation reservation until 10th of November 2026. After this date it is not possible to change the reservations and the accommodation form will be used as the base of calculating the accommodation cost for each country delegation.



ONLINE REGISTRATION

Registration of competitors, Coaches, VIPs, Supporters and others will be coordinated by the All Europe Taekwon-Do Federation. Registration for all participants will be done in Sportdata through ITF-Online (data.itftkd.sport). Please note that there will be separate events for the AETF Ranking event (black belts) and coloured belts.

All non-competitors (for example supporters, coaches, VIPs) must be registered at the event.

Registration will be open from September 15th, 2026 to November 1st, 2026 21:00 UTC.
No registrations, changes or withdrawals are possible after this period.

Participants NOT booking their Hotel accommodation through the organizers, shall pay 100 € per person to obtain the competition ID card.

Fees:

Individual entry fees: 90€ per competitor (individual and/or team member).

Team entry fees: 75€ per team.

Coach entry fees: 40€ per coach.

No refunds will be given for any reason even if a participant is disqualified.

Entry fees must be transferred electronically and must be cleared by 15th November 2026 to the AETF Bank Account. Please remember to pay the transfer costs from your side, if the AETF has to pay for the transfer costs then you will need to pay this back on arrival.

All competitors must have full insurance, provided by national federations for their members. The organizing committee recommends that all participants get accident insurance, which is valid for the entire duration of the trip/stay.



REGISTRATION AND WEIGH-IN

A school/gym representative is obligated to collect the Tournament ID Cards for all their participants prior to Weigh-In.

Registration and weigh in will start **from 14:00** on Thursday 10th December 2026 at the Venue according to the Weigh In timetable per school/gym which will be published.

Earlier registration will be possible **from 12.00** with prior agreement with the organizers (send a request email at info.porectkd@gmail.com).

Please note!

All competitors must be present at the Weigh-In regardless of the event they compete in. If they don't make the weight **until 18:00 o'clock**, then they shall be removed from the sparring category and shall not be allowed to enter any other weight category.

The competitors must also be in possession of a valid identification document (passport/national ID), EuroCup 2026 official ID cards, (and for the ranking tournament an ITF small black belt card)

All competitors must make the weight in their ITF approved dobok trousers and T- or polo shirt. In order for an athlete to compete, their verified weight **MUST** fall within the prescribed minimum and maximum weights (+500 grams) for the division in which they officially registered.

All competitors must bring a printed and signed copy of the "Declaration of consent Form" which is an integral part of this invitation (form available at the AETF website <https://itfeurope.org/open-european-cup-2026/>)

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COACHES

For individual or team competition there will be only one (1) coach close to the square. During the tournament, coaches must wear a training suit, gymnastic shoes and carry a towel. Failure to abide by the above mentioned rules may render the coach liable to be disqualified from his advisory position.

UMPIRES

Umpires shall arrive on Thursday December 10th ,2026 or before 18.00 hrs. and depart on Sunday December 13th after 14.00 hrs.

Any participating school / gym may provide umpires at their own costs. To be selected as official AETF umpire and be reimbursed your hotel costs and paid a small stipend, you should adhere to the following criteria:

Candidates must be Active Umpires.

Candidates must be supported by their national or allied association.

Candidates who attended the EQUC within two (2) years prior to the cup have selection advantage.

Candidates with an ITF International umpire license have selection advantage.

Selected umpires for the AETF European Cup must have attended the mandatory Teams sessions.

The AETF Umpire Committee strongly encourages umpires who want to be selected for future AETF European Championships to apply for this AETF European Cup, so that they can demonstrate their skills and abilities in a relatively safe environment.

1. Umpires will be accommodated in twin/double (2 persons) rooms.
2. Where an Umpire is sharing accommodation, the guest will need to pay the rate of €60,00 per day
3. Umpires wishing to be accommodated in a single room will have to pay an extra fee of €40,00 per day. Please note that single rooms are limited and this option is valid in case of availability.
4. Umpires dress code requirements as laid down in the Official ITF Rules of Competition
